- 5.1 Current enforcement cases: no new cases
- 5.2 Lengthsman : Cllr Hunt stated for the record that he is not intending to apply for the advertised position. Clerk informed the meeting that an application had been received from East Cornworthy and Cllr Hunt agreed to liaise with the applicant to furnish them with more details about the work involved.
- 5.3 Cllr Hunt read out a letter from a parishioner that had been sent to South West Water (SWW) complaining about the debris coming up at property in Cornworthy from the sewage system after periods of heavy rain. Cllr Fry suggested that we should liaise with SWW to try and obtain a map of their pipework below ground at Cornworthy to help with future issue including planning. Clerk to investigate.
